Math—WAR

Play WAR with someone in your family or with a friend on zoom. Each person starts with $\frac{1}{2}$ a deck of cards. Take out the kings, queens, jacks and jokers. To play, each person flips a card. Say the number on your card and then ask

WHO HAS MORE?

Whoever has more wins both cards. If the card is a tie, flip another 2 cards and see who has more. The winner gets all 4 cards. Count your cards at the end to see who is the winner.

Science- Force and Motion

Find 2 round things, 2 cubes and 2 pyramids and a toy vehicle that you are allowed to play with in your home.

Find a large book, board, or piece of cardboard to make a ramp. Try placing the items you picked at the top of the ramp and see what happens when you let go. How do the items get down the ramp? Did they move on their own? Did you have to do something to make them move? Try covering your ramp with something smooth, something rough, something bumpy. Does it change how the objects move and how far they go?

Pull out the green and yellow letter cards and try to put them in order.

See how fast you can put them in order? Have someone time you and see if you can get faster each time.
